First Sail Experience

First Sail is a US Sailing initiative offered to beginners as an introduction to sailing in a casual setting and designed to provide a memorable experience that will motivate newcomers to continue sailing. Each first sail experience consists of two sessions, with

the first introducing the basics of sailing and the following week getting out on Lake Michigan to experience the joy of sailing for yourself.

We have three First Sail Experiences available for just \$50/per person.
